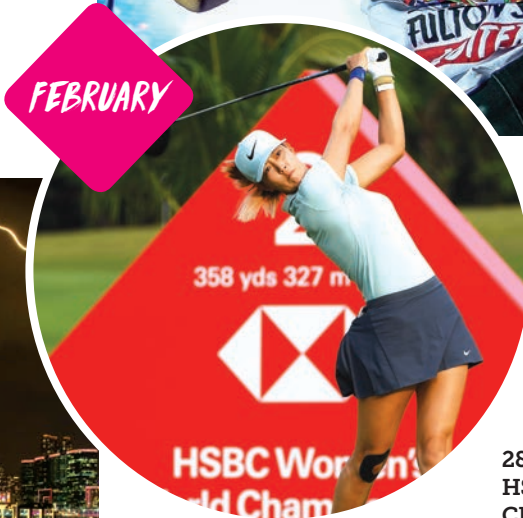
LET THERE BE ROCK
